FFE Board of Directors Application Form

The Kalamazoo Foundation for Excellence (FFE) helps empower Kalamazoo City residents to achieve the lives they want for themselves and their families. The FEE provides funding to the City of Kalamazoo each year to 1) stabilize its budget 2) lower the City property tax rate and 3) invest in aspirational projects that advance the Imagine Kalamazoo Vision. Board members are responsible for governing the FFE organization and endowment so that it lasts forever to support the City of Kalamazoo. Board members are expected to attend four in-person Board meetings annually. Printed materials are provided prior to each Board meeting that require thoughtful reading and consideration.

Due to a vacancy the <u>Affinity Organization Stakeholder</u> seat is open and seeks applicants. They have an initial term of 9/23/2024 - 5/31/2026, with opportunities to renew for an additional three-year term of service. This is a volunteer role.

The <u>Affinity Organizations Stakeholder shall be drawn from a group of persons representing nonprofit</u> organizations whose mission or purpose as stated in its Articles of Incorporation is to advocate for and/or provide supportive services to local families and individuals; provided, however, the representative shall not include a person from any of the other Stakeholder Groups (Arts, Business/Banking, Education, Faith-Based, Healthcare, Housing, Neighborhood).

No person may serve as a Stakeholder Director who is a disqualified person as defined by the City of Kalamazoo Code or its Regulations; a person who could cause the Corporation to be determined a private foundation; or a person in default to the City of Kalamazoo. Applications are vetted once received to ensure compliance with these rules. All successful directors must abide by and fulfill the FFE Bylaws and Articles and roster of policies including Engagement Expectations and Attendance Policy. Meetings all require in-person attendance.

All applications must be received by 11:59PM EST on July 31, 2024. Online applications are strongly encouraged. Monday, July 1, 2024 – Application period opens. (8:00AM EST) Wednesday, July 31, 2024 – Application period closes (11:59PM EST). August 2024 – Committee reviews applications and City Commission votes to approve candidate. September 2024 – FFE board votes on candidate. Board term begins.
